Boulder County Fair

Both classes will be visiting the Boulder County Fair the first week of August. The children will view farm animals, exhibits, and their own artwork that is on display. We ask for all children to wear a hat and closed-toe shoes on this day (no Crocs or sandals). We will leave at 9:30AM and return by 11:30AM. Parent volunteers will be needed for the trips. A sign-up sheet will be posted for those who will be able to help out.

Gardening Days

Each Friday we take a group of 15 students to St. Brigit's garden in Frederick. Our students are caring for and harvesting two raised beds at the garden. Students who wear closed-toe shoes (no Crocs or sandals) will be permitted to participate every other week.

Pizza Day

On Wednesday, August 11, we will have our final Pizza Day of the summer. We appreciate all of the parental support we have received at our previous Pizza Days. A sign-up sheet will be posted for all who can help out on this last fun event. Thank you.

Bike Day

On Thursday, August 12, we will hold our final Bike Day of the summer. Each student is asked to bring a bike and helmet to school on this special day. The parking lot will be blocked off to traffic so that the children can ride around the entire building. Bike races are also planned for the day.

On Tuesday, August 17, we will have our final PJ & Movie Day for the summer. Children are encouraged to wear their pajamas to school and bring a blanket, pillow, stuffed animal, or sleeping bag. Any G-rated movies that your family may have in your personal library are appreciated to use for the day.
